- 2. Whenever you disobey, you are saying you know better than God.
- 3. Remember, God's number one goal is always to draw people to Himself.

III. Read Chapter 2

- God deals with Jonah's excuses for disobedience.
- 2. Jonah's way out of his miserable circumstances was his repentance.
- 3. Jonah had to confess God was right, even if he didn't like what He was doing.
